

Three main objectives:

- I. Build new relationships {set the course for fostering and sustaining mutually respectful relationships}
- 2. Co-development {support new directions to support new models for Indigenous research and research training}
- 3. Coordinated approach {greater harmonization, integration and coordination of research and research-related programs and policies}

Four principles of Indigenous engagement: Respect | Trust | Self-determination | Commitment

Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada: Calls to Action

- ☐ Establish national research program with multi-year funding to advance understanding of reconciliation
- ☐ Assist communities to research and produce histories of residential school experiences and involvement in truth, healing, and reconciliation
