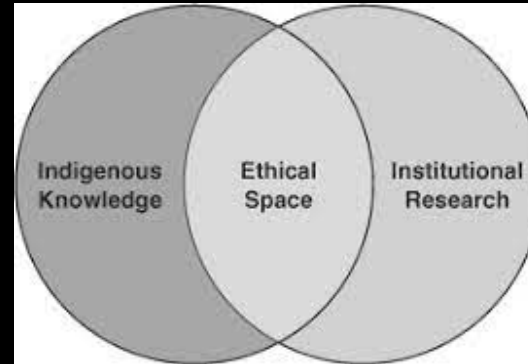

Engaging with First Nations, Inuit and Métis peoples

### Three main objectives:

1. Build new relationships {set the course for fostering and sustaining mutually respectful relationships}
2. Co-development {support new directions to support new models for Indigenous research and research training}
3. Coordinated approach {greater harmonization, integration and coordination of research and research-related programs and policies}

**Four principles of Indigenous engagement:** Respect | Trust | Self-determination | Commitment

### Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada: Calls to Action

- Research and policy development, public education programs, and resources
- Establish national research program with multi-year funding to advance understanding of reconciliation
- Assist communities to research and produce histories of residential school experiences and involvement in truth, healing, and reconciliation
