

2018 Research Administration Certificate Bursary Application Form

The CARA Bursary Program provides an opportunity for CARA to recognize and support the efforts of members who are advancing their own knowledge and the profession itself through their participation in the <u>Research Administration Certificate at Mohawk College</u>.

ELIGIBILITY

All members of CARA, in good standing (holding CARA membership at the time of the application) who are current Research Administration Certificate students.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The following criteria are **considered** in determining a recipient:

ENGAGEMENT: The individual has been engaged in CARA through activities, committees and/or

programs. The individual is committed to continuing to contributing to CARA.

➤ LEADERSHIP: The individual shows qualities that exemplify leadership, motivation and inspiration

related to participation in CARA or the profession of research administration.

> NEED: The individual demonstrates some degree of financial need.

ACHIEVEMENT: Any notable achievements within the CARA in particular or the applicant's

institution/community.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

That the busaries be available through an application process that includes critiera based on both merit and need.

That the bursary awarded through CARA belongs to the individual member and are non transferable.

That bursary funds may be used for the following: <u>Research Administration Certificate</u> at Mohawk College (registration and books and/or CARA membership).

SELECTION

The CARA Executive Committee is responsible for the Bursary Program. All activities of the program shall be in accordance with CARA approved policies and procedures and the above guiding principles. The confidential selection process is conducted by CARA volunteers, at least one of whom is a member of the CARA Board of Directors and their decision is final. The recipients will be notified on an individual basis.
